## Payment and Pick-up

If you registered a credit card as part of the online portion of the auction or “pre-swiped” your credit card, you will be automatically checked out at the conclusion of the Live Auction and a receipt will be emailed to you. Please proceed directly to the 8<sup>th</sup> grade classroom to pick up your winnings.

If you have an issue with your receipt or would like to pay by cash/check, please proceed to the check-out table.

**Successful bidders of Silent and Live Auction items need to pay for and pick up their items upstairs before going home. All sales are final.**

Check-out will begin at 10:30 pm and will close for the evening at 11:30 pm.

Payment & pick-up continues on Sunday, January 26th from 9 am – 12:30 pm.

Most items & services must be used by December 31, 2020 unless otherwise noted.

# SILENT AUCTION PROTOCOL

## To bid on items, you need a bidder number

There are several ways to get a bidder number:

- When you buy your tickets for the Auction online at **[www.ccfeed.org/tickets](http://www.ccfeed.org/tickets)**
- When you check-in into the Online Auction at **[www.ccfeed.org/auction](http://www.ccfeed.org/auction)**
- At the Silent Auction Preview (January 25<sup>th</sup>, Noon – 1:00 pm at the school)
- When you come to the Auction Event (January 25<sup>th</sup>, bidding starting at 5:30 pm)

To bid on a specific item, please enter your bidder number, family name, and bid amount on the appropriate bid sheet. All three are required.

Be sure to note what type of bidding rule is in place. For example:

- **Highest bidder wins:** If you really want the item, your bid needs to be the highest one when the tables close.
- **Six highest bidders win:** If your bid is one of the six highest bids when the tables close, you win! Winning bids may not be for the same amount, but the six highest will win.
- **Party maximum:** Pay close attention to the maximum allowed at each party and whether you are asked to sign up per-person or per-couple/family.
- **Progressive bidding:** The highest bidders win. They are determined by working from the last page to the first, and from the bottom of the bid sheet to the top.

Please respect minimum bid and raise amounts printed on the bid sheets. To 'raise' an existing bid, enter your bidder number, name and bid amount on the next available line on the bid sheet.

Please be sure to write the correct bidder number and name down and print clearly.

Only use your assigned bidder number. Do not bid for other families.

Please do not block other bidders from bidding on an item.

Bids may not be crossed out or erased.

**All Silent Auction sales are final.** If you have a change of heart or a change of plans that cause a conflict with a party or other winning item, it is up to you to 'sell' your spot to someone else. The Silent Auction committee will not issue any refunds except in the case of data entry errors.

Please observe table closing times. Tables will start closing at 7:15 pm. The Table Closers will draw a line through the bid sheet when bidding is closed on that item.

Please stand back when the Table Closer reaches the bid sheet. When the bid sheet is 'closed', no more bids are allowed on that item.

Please do not remove bid sheets from the tables.

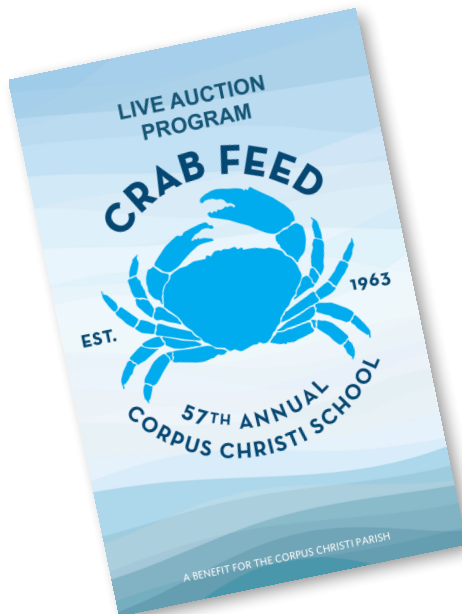


